First: General Specifications of a Psychology Teacher Graduate

In addition to the specifications related to the specialization, a psychology graduate should be able to:

- 1- Design a teaching plan in the field of psychology and educational environments that suit the diversity of learners.
- 2- Implement teaching methods utilizing educational technology, taking into account the characteristics of learners and their learning styles.
- 3- Use appropriate methods and tools to evaluate the various aspects of the teaching and learning processes.
- 4- Deal professionally with students with special needs who are eligible for educational inclusion.
- 5- Develop themselves professionally and build diverse professional relationships.
- 6- Understand the unity of knowledge and the complementary relationships between the various branches of science.
- 7- Employ mechanisms of educational and psychological guidance and counseling, as well as entrepreneurship, in their professional practices.
- 8- Communicate effectively using their personal abilities and information and communication technology skills.
- 9- Understands recent developments related to educational psychology.
- 10- Communicates fluently in Arabic and in at least one foreign language.
